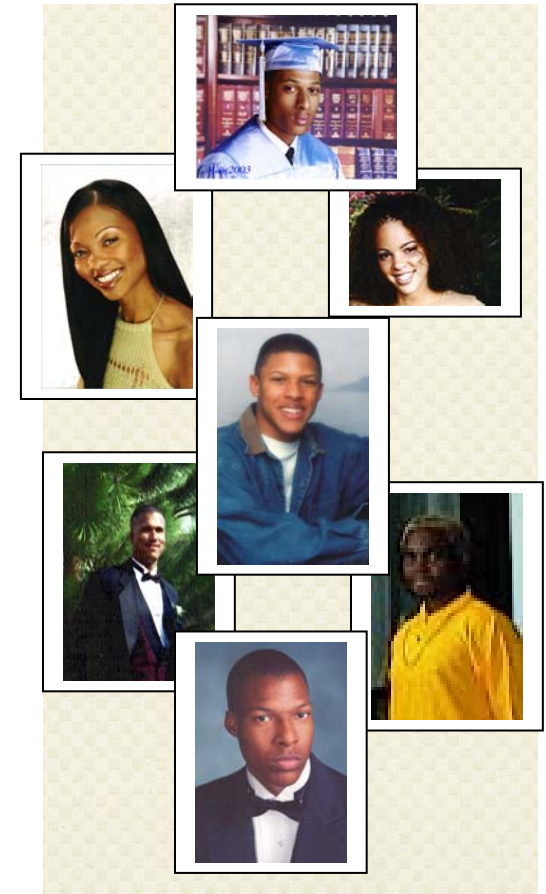

- Foster children homes

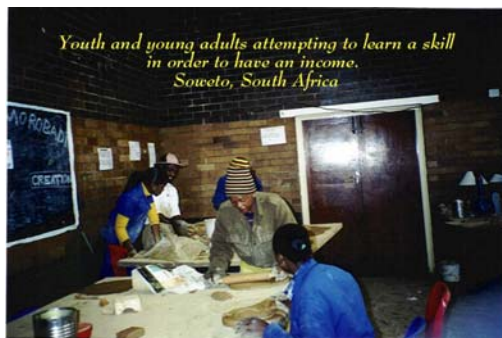
